Calogero named CEO of NYHC

Judith A. Calogero, 51, former New York State Commissioner of the Division of Housing and Community Renewal, has been appointed Chief Executive Officer of the New York Housing Conference. Her appointment was announced at the NYHC/NHC 35th Anniversary Luncheon, a key platform for the affordable housing cause.

Calogero's appointment, effective Jan. 1, fills the leadership vacancy left in 2007 with the passing of NYHC Founder

Clara Fox. Fox had guided the organization from its inception in 1973.

Calogero said, "Now, more than ever, there is a need for affordable housing. There is no better way to jump start America's troubled economy than to create housing which in turn creates jobs and vital infrastructure improvements. My primary mission will be to stimulate legislation on the federal, state and local levels to spur housing and community development in New York."
